Detailed description	<ul> <li>Valid for 24 hours after ticket issuance for one journey from the Břeclav border (Czechia), Marchegg border, Kittsee border (Slovakia), or Hegyeshalom border (Hungary) as well as Vienna Central Station and Graz Central Station to an ÖBB railway station in Austria or to the Passau station (Germany), Buchs SG station (Switzerland), Brennero/Brenner station, or Tarvisio Boscoverde station (Italy)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Valid in trains operated by ÖBB for a single journey in 2nd class within Austria from one of the border stations or from Vienna Central Station or Graz Central Station.</li> </ul>
	• Issued directly in the train by the train attendant on cross-border journeys. If a displaced person does not encounter a train attendant in the train or does not enter Austria by train, a ticket will be issued (solely) at the travel centres in Vienna Central Station or Graz Central Station.
